Summary:

The Tony Elumelu Foundation is the leading philanthropy empowering a new generation of African entrepreneurs, driving poverty eradication, catalysing job creation across all 54 African countries, and increasing women's economic empowerment.

Since the launch of the TEF Entrepreneurship Programme in 2015, the Foundation has trained over 2.5 million young Africans on its digital hub, TEFConnect, and disbursed nearly USD \$100 million in direct funding to 21,000 African women and men, who have collectively created over 1.5 million direct and indirect jobs.

The Foundation's mission is rooted in Africapitalism, which positions the private sector, and most importantly, entrepreneurs, as the catalyst for the social and economic development of the African continent. The Foundation's ability to fund, train, mentor, and network young African entrepreneurs has created a unique platform for catalysing growth across the African continent.

The robust ability of the Foundation to reach entrepreneurs across geographies and sectors, has enabled it to conduct innovative partnerships with the European Union (EU), United Nations Development Programme, the International Committee of the Red Cross, the United States Government via the United States African Development Foundation (USADF), The Organization of African, Caribbean and Pacific States (OACPS), The French Development Agency (AFD), The German Development Finance Institution (DEG), The German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ), The African Development Bank (AfDB), and Google, with bespoke programmes including targeting female empowerment and growth in fragile states.

As part of the TEF-GIZ-EU partnership, we are working to enhance the skills, knowledge, and capacity of our entrepreneurs. To achieve this goal, we have developed a green curriculum designed to empower our female entrepreneurs to thrive in the 21st century. We are currently seeking proposals from experienced graphic design and video animation firms to create an engaging and educational animated graphics and video series for this green training curriculum.

This project aims to enhance the learning experience for our participants by utilising high-quality graphics and animations that effectively convey complex concepts while maintaining viewer engagement. We are committed to delivering exceptional educational content, and this initiative is a vital component of our strategy to provide innovative and impactful training programs.

Objectives of this Project

The goal of this project is to create graphics and animated videos that cover a variety of green topics in an engaging and informative way. These resources are designed to equip learners with the knowledge and skills necessary to adapt to rapidly evolving digital technologies and stay current with the latest trends.

In detail, the selected vendor will be responsible for creating a series of animated videos with the following objectives:

- 1. Develop Animated Videos: Create animated videos covering all 13 training modules in English, Arabic, French, and Portuguese.
- 2. Engaging Storytelling: Use engaging storytelling techniques to explain complex concepts simply and understandably.
- 3. Educational Content: Ensure that the videos are educational, adhering to the provided curriculum guidelines.
- 4. High-Quality Animations: Produce high-quality animations that are visually appealing and maintain viewer interest.
- 5. Voiceover and Subtitles: Include professional voiceover and subtitles in English, Arabic, French, and Portuguese

Target Audience:

Our programme content is designed to empower African women entrepreneurs by strengthening their skills in the green sector and equipping them with the knowledge and tools needed to thrive in a rapidly evolving landscape.

Scope of Work:

The selected vendor will be responsible for:

1. Concept Development:

 Work with our team to develop a clear understanding of the training objectives and key messages.



 Create storyboards and scripts for each video, ensuring alignment with the curriculum.

2. Animation Production:

- Design and animate African characters, scenes, and transitions.
- Incorporate feedback from our team at each stage of production.

3. Post-Production:

- Add voiceovers, sound effects, and background music.
- Include subtitles and ensure all videos meet accessibility standards.

4. Review and Finalisation:

- Submit drafts for review and make necessary revisions within agreed timelines.
- Deliver all source files and final versions in the required formats.

Timeframe

The animation production project is expected to run for a 4-week timeframe.
